

Competition and Participation Rules 2019



General

The outdoortrophy is an extreme sport event. Each athlete must have adequate stamina and experience in his or her discipline. Each participant must sign the competition rules when the starting numbers are distributed; otherwise, starting permission will not be granted. Furthermore, participation in the competition meeting is mandatory. The route is open for inspection. It is the responsibility of each competitor to train on and/or inspect the individual sections of the route. The organizer does not assume any liability for damages (including third parties). In addition, the rights of the respective property owners must be observed outside of the official training times.

Eligibility

All persons who are age 18 or older are eligible to enter. Participation for those between 16 and 18 years is only possible with the special written approval of the outdoortrophy organizational committee and the consent of the parents.

Anmeldung

On the Internet at www.outdoortrophy.com. Registration is valid when the completed registration card (e-mail/paper) and entry fee have been received. The entry fee is 240.00 euros per team, early bird 200.- euros until 01/31/2019. For Solo and Single athletes EUR 60.00 (plus bank charges). Closing date for entry is 05/18/2019. Changes are possible until 06/09/2019. The entry fee includes: lift tickets (mountain run + para) on the day of the competition, discounted lift use starting on 06/13/2019, free parking spaces, route marking and securing, compensation for helpers, result list, pasta party (Friday after the competition meeting), cake and fruit buffet, showers, admission to the outdoortrophy Night at the HIGH 5, outdoortrophy t-shirt, cash prizes of € 13,000.00, and valuable non-cash prizes.

Timekeeping

Each competitor receives a chip for timekeeping. This chip must be worn on the body at all times! There are checkpoints along the route that display the time and transmit it in real time to the Internet and the scoreboards on the start/finish area. Anyone who forgets or loses the chip will be disqualified.

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Cancellations

Are only possible in writing and with a medical attestation until 06/28/2019 (100% of the entry fee will be reimbursed).

Changes in Registration

It is possible to change the participants until 06/09/2019! Later changes will be subject to a fee of 10.00 EUROS!

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Route Lengths

Mountain run: 12 km / 1116 hm, forest paths, steep and narrow mountain trails
Paragliding: 7.5 km, 10 min. run, start, marker buoy, target precision landing
Kayak: 6 km, 4 m cliff start, waterfall, rapids, slalom, Eskimo roll
Mountainbike: 31.2 km / 1636 hm, forest paths, trails, connecting passages, downhill

Health

Each person is responsible for making sure that he or she can handle the physical demands of the competition. Everyone participates at his or her own risk!

Safety

Helmets are mandatory for bikers, paragliders, and kayakers.
Each person must pay attention to his or her own safety, act accordingly, and stop competing if necessary.

Food and Drinks

Drinks and food will be made available for the bikers and runners during the competition. After the discipline, mountainbikers, mountain runners, paragliders and kayakers will receive beverages. In addition, pasta meals are available for all competitors at the finish line.

Training

Training is solely at the risk of each participant. The route is only open for inspection. The route will already have signs posted on Wednesday, August 12, 2015. The route is NOT closed to traffic!

Liability

Participation in the outdoortrophy is connected with certain and uncertain risks. The organizer, the participating communities, the road maintainers, the tourism associations, and all staff members of the event reject any type of liability for all claims of any type and the resulting consequences for the participants, also including toward third parties - before, during, and after the event! Each competitor participates at his or her own risk. In addition, each participant must confirm with his or her signature that he or she has valid personal liability insurance coverage.

Lost-and-Find Office

In addition, no liability will be assumed for lost or stolen objects. Found or lost objects can be handed in and picked up at the competition office.

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Insurance

All participants must assure that they have valid insurance that covers the consequences of a possible accident during the event and the damages that it could cause to third parties! Rules / Disqualification The mass-start lineup is organized according to pro/amateur/women, as well as last year's results. The competition committee reserves the right to amend and/or supplement the rules at any time. The STVO (traffic regulations) must be observed at all times!

Reasons for Disqualification

- No outside help is permitted during the race (riding in the slipstream, carrying the bike.....)
- Participants who arrive too late at the start
- Not passing the check points
- Lost timekeeping chip
- Using blocked sections of the route
- Not following the instructions of the safety personal
- Not obeying the valid rules and/or instructions from the competition supervision
- Throwing garbage outside of the marked garbage sectors
- No starting permission and no evaluation without a number
- Flying without rescue equipment
- Paragliders reaching the goal without their complete gear (equipment, helmet, belt, parachute, rescue equipment)
- Not reaching the marker buoy
- No valid number on the parachute
- Number cannot be recognized
- Not waved through
- Reckless flying
- Doping

Pro / Amateur

Each team may start in the pro class. The following restrictions apply to the amateurs: Teams with one or more participants who have finished in the past 2 years among the Top 5 of the individual results (pro or amateur class), or among the Top 10 in the World or Continental Championships and/or the Olympic Games, or among the Top 3 in the World Cup overall rankings overall rankings are ineligible to start in the amateur class.

Accidents

Accidents and injuries must be reported to the competition supervision (competition office) immediately.

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Protest

Any type of protest must be submitted in writing at the latest 30 minutes after the arrival of the last competitors at the competition office with a deposit of 100.00 euros. The competition committee will decide on all questions in dispute. If the protest is sustained, the deposit will be refunded to the participant.

Sponsor Spaces

It is prohibited for any of the participants to cover up or remove any type of sponsor spaces (starting numbers, banners, etc.). Furthermore, it is prohibited to post your own sponsors along the route. As an exception to the above-mentioned restrictions, body surfaces and the surfaces of the respective sports equipment may be used.

Starting Numbers

Handlebar numbers must be mounted on the handlebar, back numbers on the back, and chest numbers at least as high as the nipples so that the sponsor can be seen during an interview!

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Current Information

Flight weather, dam release for kayak training, and starter lists (3 days before the competition) will be on www.outdoortrophy.com

Press Conference

The press conference with the winning teams of the outdoortrophy -- pros / amateurs / women -- will take place on the day of the competition at 4 p.m. in the start/finish area. This is mandatory for the 3 winning teams, as well as the appearance of the entire team at the award ceremony - otherwise, the prize money will be withheld.

Press

The detailed result lists with pictures and press texts can be viewed after the end of the competition and the protest deadline (6:30 p.m.) on site and on the Internet. The starter list will be available on the day of the competition at the competition office or 3 days in advance with the right of the organizer to make changes on the Internet.

Mountain Run

Suitable footwear is required. Ground marking and flags. No climbing aids (spikes, sticks, etc.) allowed! Garment bag transport by the paraglider of one's own team (sufficiently warm clothing)! The STVO (traffic regulations) must always be observed! No outside assistance is permitted. Changing shoes is not permitted. Chest numbers must be at least as high as the nipples so that the sponsor of the mountain run can be seen during an interview!

Disqualification

The team will be disqualified in the case of unsportsmanlike conduct, flying without rescue equipment, reckless flying, stunt flying, not reaching the buoy, arriving at the goal WITHOUT the complete gear, weights, no valid number in the sail, as well as a violation of the rules described above. Decisions are made at the discretion of the competition supervision. The strips for the numbers, which can be easily removed after the competition, will also be issued during registration at the competition office.

License

Special pilot's license, A-license, brevet, or equivalent licenses will be recognized.

Insurance

The pilot must have valid aviation liability insurance for his/her aircraft and for himself/herself as the pilot.

Equipment

Paraglider (prototypes with type certification), harness, and rescue equipment must have a valid authorization in Austria. Foreign participants require the evidence of operating ability that is stipulated in their native countries. If pieces of equipment require a legally regulated certification, they must be presented upon request. Helmets and rescue equipment are mandatory.

Accidents

In the case of an accident that results in the discontinuation of the flight competition, this will be signalled by a white cross at the landing site. Additionally a smoke cartridge will be ignited. All pilots who are still in the air must then fly to the landing site at the Andelsbuch cable railway. The further procedure remains the same as under „Discontinuation of the Competition.“

Kayaking

The water rescue is posted at the start and the finish. Moreover, a vehicle is on standby. No outside assistance is permitted. Exception: change of paddle in case of break, as well as emergency measures by the water rescue in case of lack of response from a participant! If the participant signals OK, assistance will not be given! No rescue of material. Kayak numbers must be attached to the chest and the back! Slalom gates must be maneuvered around in the given order! A time penalty must be served for each gate error! This will be announced by a judge by means of a whistle and a sign and also lifted again.

Rules / Reasons for Disqualification

Each canoeist must wear a life jacket that meets the regulations of the ICF! A helmet and an appropriate footwear (barefoot is prohibited due to the danger of injury) is also mandatory.

Kayak Dimensions

Maximum length of 380 cm. Only original boats. Material: HTP or PE. No Kevlar, no carbon, no polyester, and no keel. Boat inspection before the start!

Kayak Training

Friday, 06/21/2019: Course inspection and training kayak start at the KW Andelsbuch power station (around 3 p.m.)

Mountainbike

Each participant is responsible for his or her own bike. Exchanging bikes or rims during the competition is not permitted! A technical bike inspection will not take place. The STVO (traffic regulations) must always be observed! No outside assistance is permitted (riding in the slipstream, towing, carrying the bike...)
